To be a centre of excellence for the implementation of EU programmes

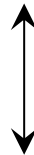

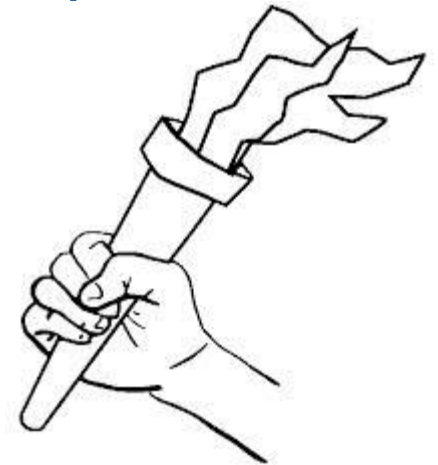

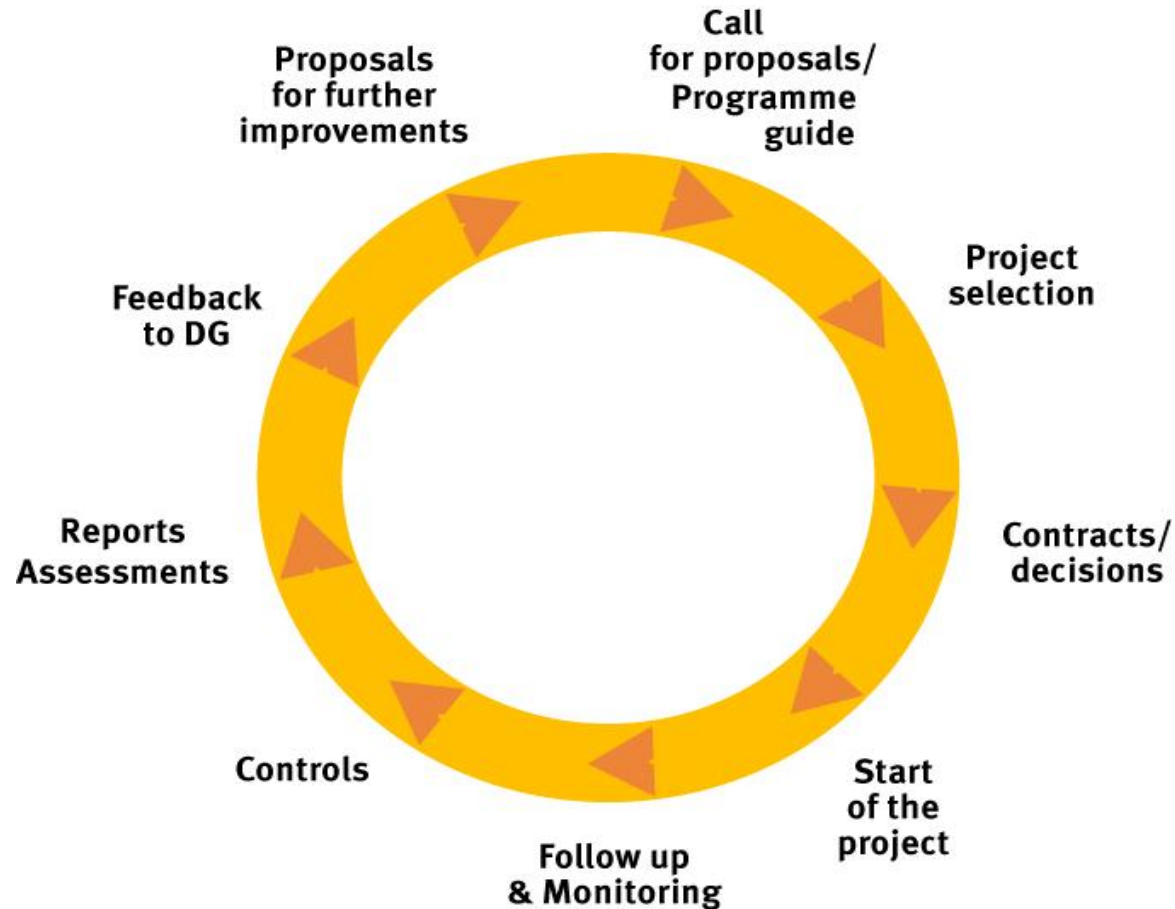

 - Dialogue with European stakeholders
