

ERASMUS MUNDUS ACTION 2 – STRAND 1

GUIDELINES TO THE CALL FOR PROPOSALS EACEA 41/10

CORRIGENDUM

The present corrigendum concerns the inclusion of **Argentina** in Erasmus Mundus Action 2 - Strand 1 Call for proposals EACEA 41/10 as published on 16/12/2010. The addition of two lots (N° 16-A and N° 16-B) concerns section 4 and section 5.3.1 of the Guidelines as indicated below.

4 BUDGET

The overall available amount under this Call for Proposals is approximately **EUR 100.8 million**, aiming at a minimum mobility flow of **3 475 individuals**.

The available budget for EMA2 –STRAND1 is **EUR 94.5 million** aiming at a minimum mobility of **3 335 individuals**.

5.3.1.8 ARGENTINA

a. EC budget available - The overall budget available for this window is **€ 5.2 million**.

b. Partnership composition - Concerning the participation of third-country institutions, the partnership composition must include at least **five public higher education institutions** from Argentina.

It is imperative that, in their minimum composition, partnership include public higher education institutions from at least one of the regions of the Republic of Argentina with lower human development index (HDI, UNDP) as following:

- Northwest Province: Santiago del Estero, Tucumán, Catamarca, Salta y Jujuy

- Northeast Province: Chaco, Formosa, Corrientes y Misiones

c. Type of mobility and distribution - The type of mobility and the distribution for this geographical window is as follows:

Type of mobility (No European mobility allowed under this lot)	Distribution
Doctorate 'sandwich' ¹	55-65 % of the total
Full Doctorate ²	5-15 % of the total
Post-doctorate	10-20 % of the total
Staff	10-20 % of the total

- The mobility of students and academic staff from Target Group 1 shall represent at least 75% of individual mobility covered by the action.
- The mobility flows do not comprise Target Group 3.

¹ This term is used to describe the mobility of a student from Argentina that makes a part of their doctorate course in an European university. The mobility can be between six and ten months (one semester or a full academic year) in an European University

e. Project duration - The duration of the project can not exceed 48 months.
