	<p>DUNIA BEAM project will contribute to the specific objectives of EMA2-STRAND 1:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ To contribute to the mutual enrichment of societies by developing the qualifications of men and women so that they possess appropriate skills, particularly as regards the labour market, and are open-minded and internationally experienced; ▪ To promote mobility both for students, researchers, academics and administrative staff from third countries, especially from vulnerable groups, selected on the basis of academic excellence, to obtain qualifications and/or experience in the European Union; ▪ To contribute towards the development of human resources and the international co-operation capacity of higher education institutions in third-countries through increased mobility streams between the EU and third-countries in accordance with the principles of equal opportunities and non-discrimination. <p>The principal objectives of the project are to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Contribute through the exchanges of students, researchers and academic staff to the reinforcement of sustainable educational, political, cultural, economical, scientific, and technological links between EU and Middle-East. ▪ Create high quality joint diploma and research schemes as well as build the capacity of the administrative staff involved internationally ▪ Promote the co-operations between Middle-East and EU Universities in view of a better knowledge and understanding between people. ▪ Foster procedures for common recognition of syllabuses and diplomas using ECTS and the Diploma Supplement system in order to increase career opportunities for Middle-East students in that region without encouraging "brain drain" from South to North. ▪ Contribute to the development within the Middle-East Universities of the management of student and staff mobilities by implementing adequate awareness, communication and management procedures. ▪ Help Middle-East Universities to implement HE reforms by exchanging and disseminating the experiences and good practices EU Universities have developed according to the Bologna process.
	<p>Brief description:</p> <p>The choice of two words, one Arab (DUNIA means "World") and one in a European language (BEAM) intends to emphasize the presence of academic alliance between Europe and the Middle East, in respect of socio-cultural traditions of each, but as equals.</p> <p>In fact, DUNIA BEAM project consortium includes 11 Universities from lot-2 countries (3 from Jordan, 3 from Lebanon, 3 from Palestine and 2 from Syria).</p> <p>An-Najah National University - PS (which is the co-coordinator of DUNIA BEAM project); Bethlehem University - PS, Jami'at Birzeit - PS, Université Saint-Joseph - LB, American University of Beirut - LB, Lebanese American University - LB, Jordan University of Science and Technology - JO, University of Jordan - JO, Princess Sumaya University for Technology - JO, Arab International University, University of Damascus - SY.</p> <p>and 9 Universities from 8 EU countries:</p> <p>Università degli Studi di Pavia - IT, Aarhus Universitet - DK, Freie Universität Berlin - DE, Università degli Studi di Bologna - IT, Universidad de Granada - ES, Université Catholique de Louvain - BE, Université Montpellier 2 Sciences et Techniques - FR, Uppsala Universitet - SE, Vilniaus Universitetas - LT.</p> <p>The project will be coordinated by the University of Pavia which has a long lasting experience of European projects management, especially in the Region.</p> <p>The consortium will also include 16 associates who will be involved at various levels, and specifically into 1) the promotion and implementation of the individual mobility, 2) networking and regional interactions, 3) facilitation of transfer of knowledge and innovation process and 4) evaluation and sustainable development of the project. In some cases, specifically regarding to target 3 individuals, scholars have to possibility to complete all their studies and take a degree in Europe.</p> <p>Even if the lot mobility scheme is open to all field of studies, DUNIA BEAM consortium decided to consider some priorities depending on needs of lot-2 partners: <i>Architecture, urban and regional planning, Business studies and management sciences, Engineering, technology, Mathematics, informatics, Medical sciences, Natural sciences, Social sciences.</i></p>
