Project objective:

Objectives of EMAIL II will include the following:

- To share prosperity, stability and sustainable development on a broad basis between Israel and the EU.
- To increase of cooperation between Israel and the EU,
- To promote European higher education, by enhancing the participation of Bologna experts in the project – thanks to the synergy with a running Tempus project Corinthiam where the grant holder and four Israeli partners are members.
- To promote intercultural understanding through cooperation with six Israeli HEIs by promoting dialogue on science and society issues through the organization of round tables and initiatives
- To enhance the profile and visibility of European higher education in Israel.
- To opening the debate about Internationalization of Higher Education in Israel, and particularly to develop mechanisms for recognition of studies with EU countries
- To strengthen research in Israel by establishing excellence in selected research areas
- To provide mobility opportunities to candidates from all target groups in both the EU and Israel offering equal opportunities.

Brief description:

EMAIL II is an extension of an on-going cooperation of EMAIL (call of 2010). A consortium of Higher Education Institutions and professional institutes from Israel and Europe, which covers a balanced geographical area of both regions. The present project proposal has to be seen within the frame of the ENP cooperation agreement between the European Union and Neighbouring countries, particularly in this case with Israel. Within this frame our attempt is to share prosperity, stability and sustainable development on a broad basis. Herein, cooperation in education with Israel is considered as a useful complement to the Barcelona process so as to build bridges among Mediterranean partners. One advantage herein is that Israel is one of only two non-EU countries that are fully associated to the EU's framework programmes for research and technological development. EMAIL II provides a tailor-made approach allowing to focus on research and educational areas which have not been at the centre of the cooperation process while giving the option to Israeli partners to moving at its own pace in those areas identified by the Erasmus Mundus program as priorities (i.e Implementation of recognition mechanisms, promotion and application of EHEA tools, etc).

EMAIL II offers mobility opportunities of all levels and types of study/research/teaching/training for students, researchers and staff, mobility flows are available for all the three target groups defined by the Erasmus Mundus Action II program.

All partner and associated partner institutions were chosen carefully and strategically to make sure to keep a diversity, geographical and thematic fields' coverage in both the EU and Israel, to ensure a harmonic cooperation based on a history of strong cooperation and mutual trust and to serve the

needs of the consortium to achieve the objectives of the Erasmus Mundus Action II programme. All institutions are of high academic profile and commitment to international cooperation.
