	<b>Project objectives:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To better adapt the institutions from Lot 1 countries to contribute to national development needs and to respond to globalization challenges.</li> <li>To better integrate the Third-Country universities within the Euro-Mediterranean area.</li> <li>To contribute to the mutual enrichment of societies by developing the qualifications of the three target groups at all levels.</li> </ul>		
	<b>Brief description:</b> <p>This project has the acronym <b>EU-METALIC</b> which stands for “<b>EU – Morocco-Egypt-Tunisia-Algeria-Libya International Cooperation</b>”. The origins of this proposal and the potential for its success draw upon the experience and expertise gained from three current Erasmus Mundus Action 2, Lot 2 projects entitled FFEEBB1 (<b>Flow by Flow EU-Egypt Bridge Building</b>, reference 2009/1740), FFEEBB2 (reference 2010/4998) and ELEMENT (“<b>Egypt-Lebanon-EU Mobility Exchange NeTwork</b>, reference 2011/2557) which are all coordinated by Cardiff Metropolitan University (CMET). FFEEBB1 and FFEEBB2 have successfully implemented a full mobility programme and ELEMENT has currently just adjudicated the first Call for Applications (<a href="http://www.em-element.eu">www.em-element.eu</a>). CMET is also currently coordinating a Tempus project in “Leadership in Higher Education” with three of the Egyptian and two of the Lebanese partners. The experience and know-how gained from this international cooperation is an excellent base for further activities. The present bid will profit from the past in order to enrich the previous experience over the next four years.</p> <p>The consortium consists of ten EU universities Cardiff Metropolitan University (UK), Technische Universitat Berlin (Germany), Freie Universitat Berlin (Germany), University of Graz (Austria), La Sapienza University Rome (Italy), Bologna University (Italy), University of Santiago de Compostela (Spain), University of Lorraine (France), University Montpellier 1 (France), and University of Liege (Belgium). The ten Maghreb partners are Alexandria University, Arab Academy of Science and Technology and Ain Shams University from Egypt, Sousse University and Sfax University from Tunisia, SIST and King Hassan II from Morocco, Sirte University from Libya, the University of Algiers 1 and Abou Bekr Belkaid Tlemecen University from Algeria. The consortium is</p>		

able to offer a wide variety of thematic areas which match the national needs (identified by market research) and the existing excellent contacts with the partner institutions. Great care has been taken to enlist Associate partners that can play a specific and focused role in dissemination and especially in attracting target group 2 and target group 3 scholars. The project management team has devised a transparent and fair selection procedure that will not discriminate against political state or affiliation, gender, social equity or any other disadvantaged group.

The consortium has set objectives which are in line with EMA2-Strand1 which will contribute to the mutual enrichment of Maghreb Societies and the EU not only in academic matters, but also with a view to develop work opportunities for all citizens and to diminish the brain-drain by creating societies that will attract rather than discourage its inhabitants.
