	<p>Brief description:</p> <p>EMAIL III is an Erasmus Mundus Action II project for the cooperation of higher education institutions from the EU and Israel. The consortium consists of 18 full partners and 4 associated partners, from Israel 8 HEIs and 1 NGO in the role of associated partner, from the EU, 10 HEIs and 3 associated partners (2 university networks and 1 NGO). The main activity of EMAIL III is the mobility exchange between EU and Israel in the field of Higher Education. It offers possibilities to candidates of undergraduate, master's, doctoral, post-doctoral and staff for different mobility periods. Eligible candidates of Israeli and EU nationals can apply through EMAIL III; this includes candidates from non-partners institutions in the two regions and/or graduates who obtained a university degree from the same region. EMAIL III also provides mobility possibilities for candidates from target group 3 in Israel, eligible candidates in this group are Israeli nationals of Arab minority. EMAIL III academic offer is comprehensive and offers a wide range of courses/specialties in institutions that were selected taken into consideration a wide geographical spread, variety and match of thematic offer between partners. EMAIL III consortium includes not only experienced partners but also partners with limited or no experience in Action II projects. Total of 160 mobility flows will be offered through 2 calls for applications. The percentages of mobility flows between the different target groups and levels are in accordance to the 2012 EM2 call for proposals. EMAIL III aims to bringing European higher education closer to that of Israel, to promote the Bologna process and deepen the knowledge and practice of ECTS and its recognition in Israel, to create a network of cooperation between all partners involved and build centers of research excellence in both regions. In addition, EMAIL III will help in shaping the internationalization of partners from Israel which already exists for many years already.</p>
