	<p><b>Brief description:</b></p> <p>The project proposal is integrated by 5 European institutions, 4 Central Asian Republic institutions from Kazakhstan and Uzbekistan and 4 associates partners. The key to this proposal is the successful cooperation and participation of all partners as a solid and coherent working group. The consortium will integrate the following working groups: Plenary, Executive and Quality, Selection and Recognition, and Communication and Promotion Groups. The proposed mobility activities will be implemented maintaining an effective balance between all project partners. The program incorporates three cohorts of a total 24 mobility. The figures for the distribution of mobility flows according to the type of mobility are the following: Master, 21%; Doctorates, 29%; Staff, 50%. The Central ASian and European Universities (CASEU) project wishes to promote a flexible mobility scheme focusing primarily on the demand for specific subject areas. As a result, the majority of the fields of study will be covered. The cornerstones of the CASEU project is the aim to improve the mobility methodology already in place between Europe and the Central Asian Republics, focusing on the experience of the associated members and the knowledge on internationalization of the European Partners and the Central Asian Republic partners, which will provide a great degree of added value to the academic involvement of candidates. And aims to promote the establishment and development of student (master level) as well as PhD and staff exchange programs between Kazakhs, Uzbeks and EU HEIs through unilateral mobility, placement agreements; encourage the development of future programs in various fields of study, establishing academic recognition procedures and equivalence tables for future collaborations; improve mobility mechanisms between European and Kazakhstan and Uzbekistan programs at the HEIs and to widen and strengthen the modernization on international cooperation, &amp; create a future sustainable development.</p>
