	<p>Brief description:</p> <p>The main objectives of the project are to: enhance cooperation between EU and BR in HE, through the implementation of BR students', researchers' and staff mobility; contribute to overcome the existing constraints in BR, through HE cooperation in the priority thematic areas; contribute to foster students' employability in the home country and the capacity building of BR human resources. Furthermore it aims at promoting the exchange of know-how and good practices among the partnership HEIs (EU and BR), thus creating synergies that may positively contribute to their development. EU HEIs will play an extremely important role in the mobility implementation considering the experience gained during the last 25 years within the scope of Erasmus. Also the co-coordinator (UFRGS) as well as some other BR experienced partners and associates will play a major role in the management of EBW+, as a consequence of their previous involvement in EM projects. It is expected that the most experienced constitute an example to the less experienced HEIs. The EBW+ partnership is composed of 20 HEIs that fully represent the regions' diversity: HEIs from all regions and several states in BR, as well as HEIs from 8 EU countries. As part of the strategy to widely disseminate the project throughout BR and to reach the most qualified applicants, with a particular emphasis on indigenous populations, we have included as associates other HEIs with relevance for the recruitment of TG3, as well as HEIs' associations and organizations working with indigenous peoples in the country. Brazil currently faces specific needs to which education, particularly Higher Education, may provide an answer. Being so, the mobility activities foreseen in EBW+ have been designed with the purpose of constituting a real contribution to answer those needs and constraints. At the same time, and specifically in what TG1 mobility is concerned, they will have into consideration the specific needs and priorities of each partner</p>
