	<p>Brief description:  EXPERTS–SUSTAIN guarantees the continuation of cooperation in EU-SSEA partnership (covering 12 SSEA and 7 EU countries- 13 SSEA &amp; 7 EU HEIs) and improving good practices implemented in previous EXPERTS projects in order to address sustainability via bilateral agreements, other national funding structures, Erasmus+.The project has multifaceted activities: Consortium meetings: to ensure efficient management &amp; monitoring (general/financial) and to plan activities- the working groups of EU and SSEA partners plan to further investigate the QA &amp; sustainability of the project and to explore ways to further strengthen the partnership and ensure credit transfer and academic recognition in the relevant countries. BA and MA curricula in the priority fields are modularized in line with the Bologna Process and courses measured with ECTS. EXPERTS–SUSTAIN aims at increasing the employability of university graduates through structured mobility and internships. The University-Business dialogue will at the same time contribute to the transfer of knowledge towards the society, and the growth of the economy. There will be 183 mobility flows (respecting specific country thematic needs in SSEA region) -74 % for SSEA citizens and 73% allocated to TG1. 53 % of the total mobilities are focused at sustainable cooperation through PhD, post-doc and staff outflows. Mobility of researchers, teachers and administrative staff contributes to the exchange of experiences concerning educational methods and practices, innovations, business, QA, and the development of further joint activities such as joint research projects. 50% of the staff mobility is for academics and 50% for personnel in charge of internationalization processes, institutional building and enterprise cooperation of the universities. The project will deploy a transparent dissemination through various communication tools to all (non)academic stakeholders (universities, embassies, ministries, NGO's, enterprises, social organisations).</p>
