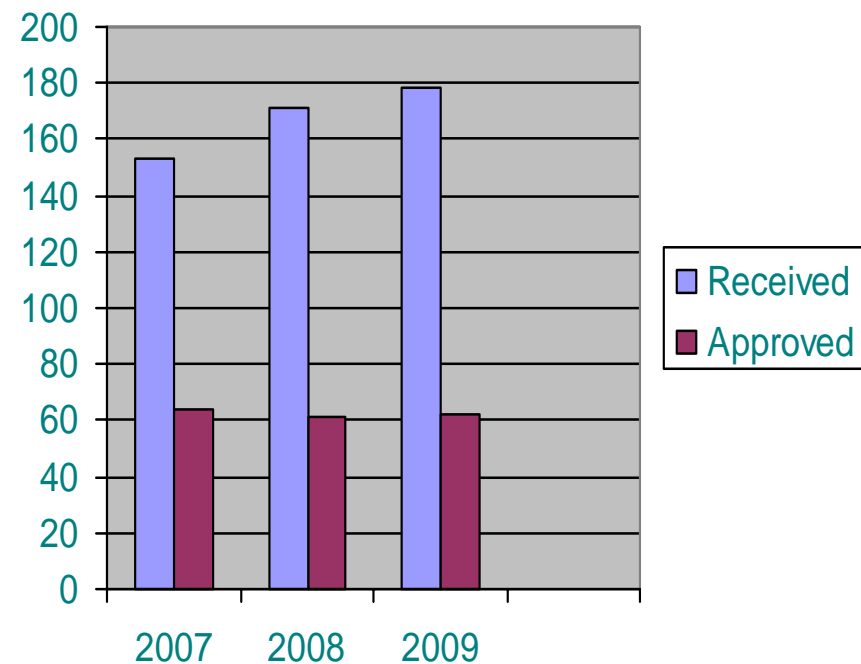

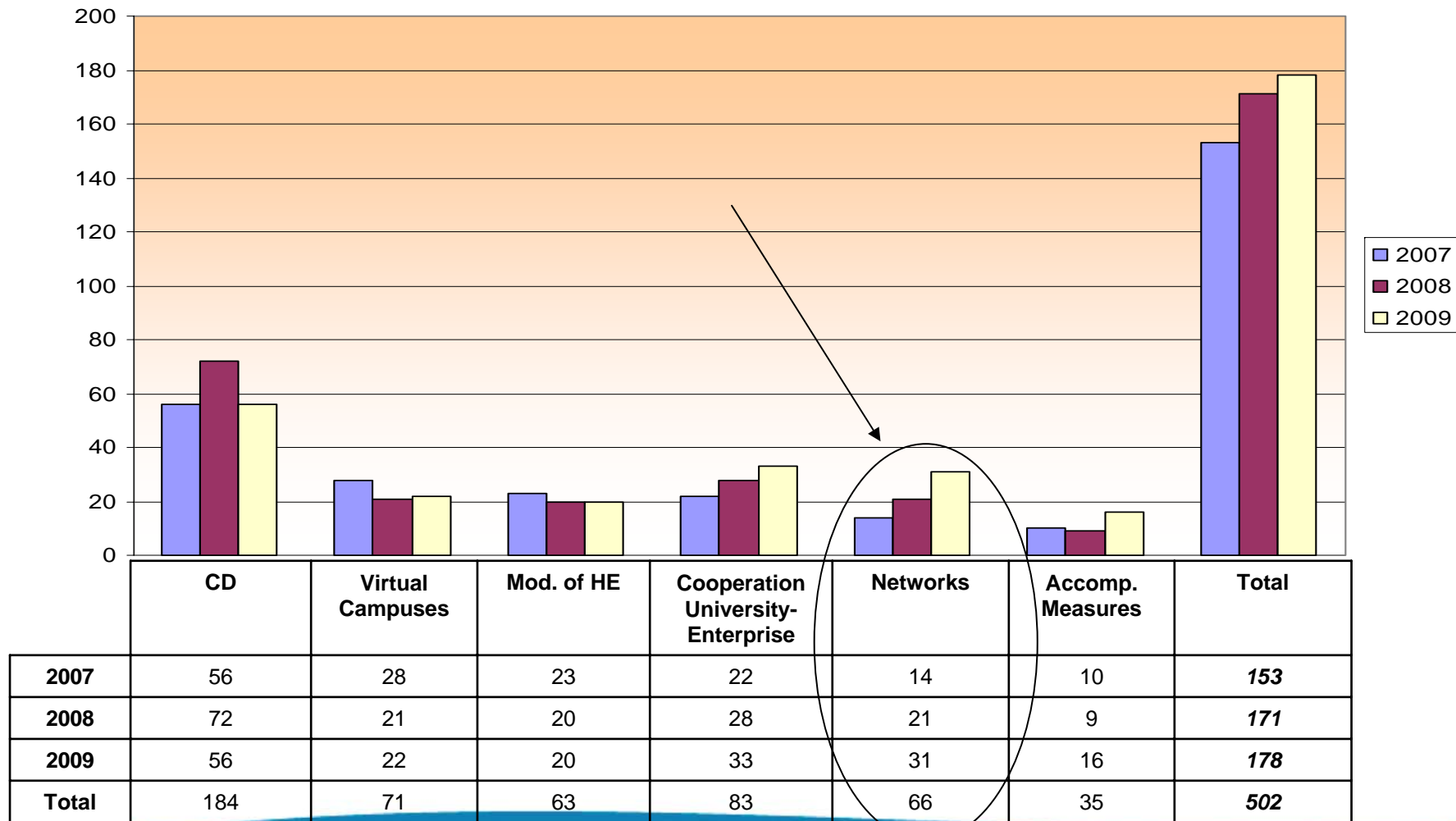

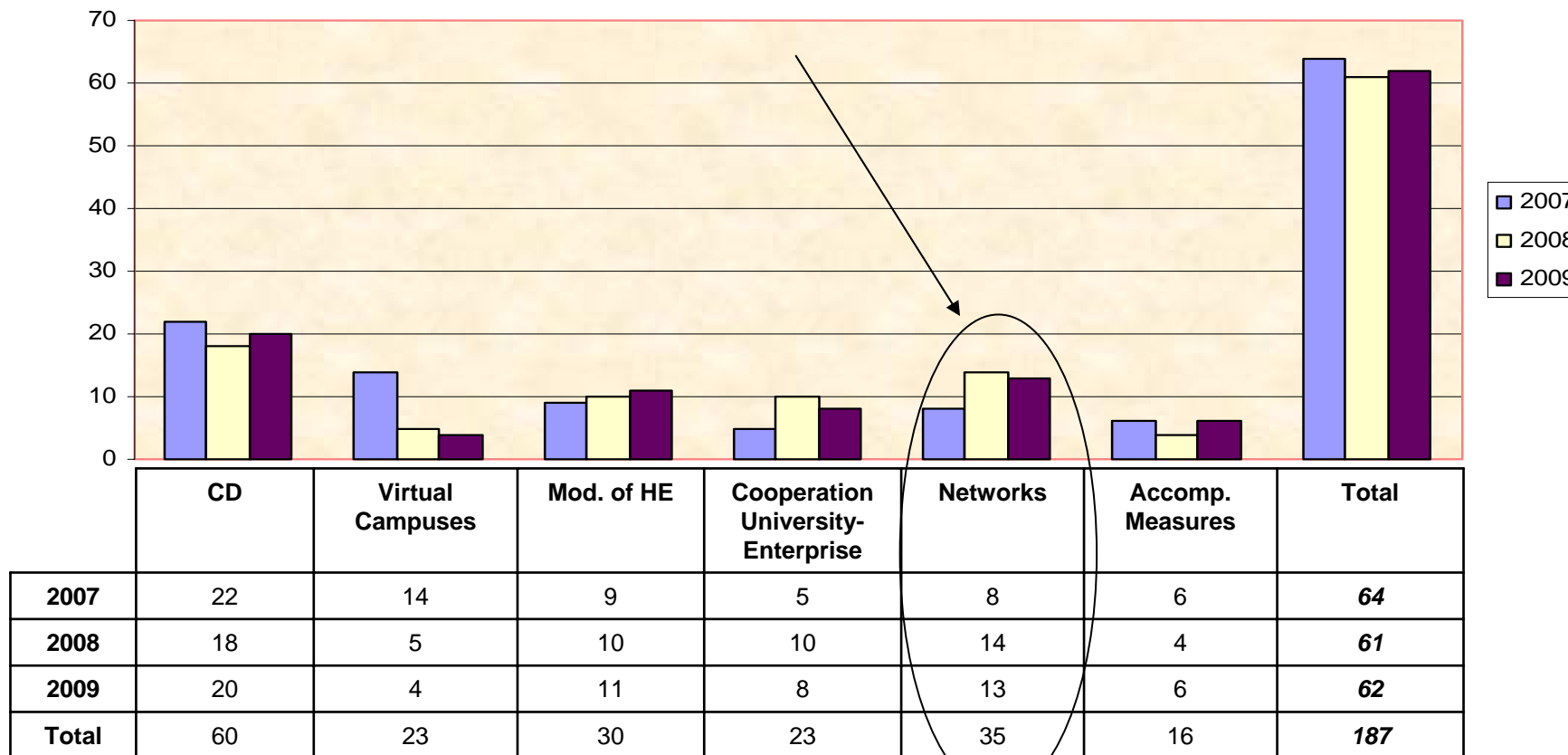

- **34.8%**

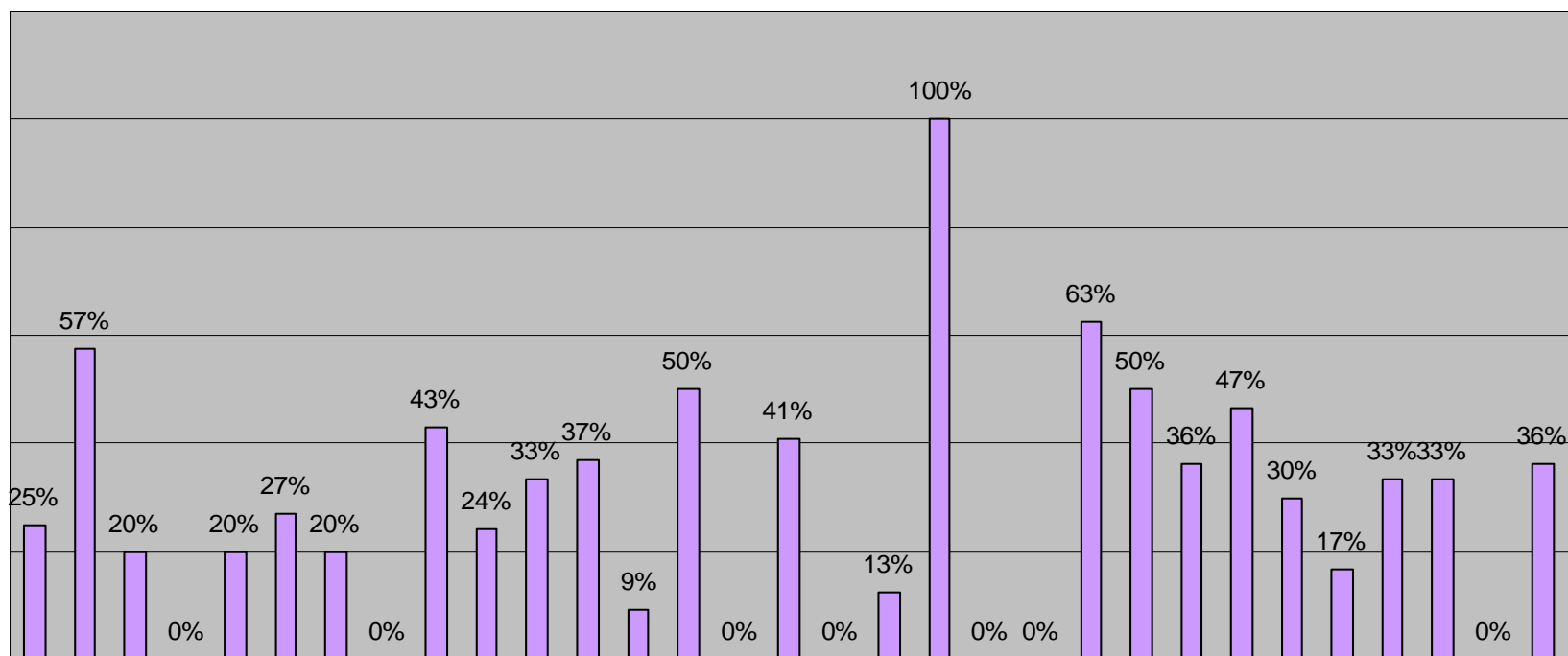








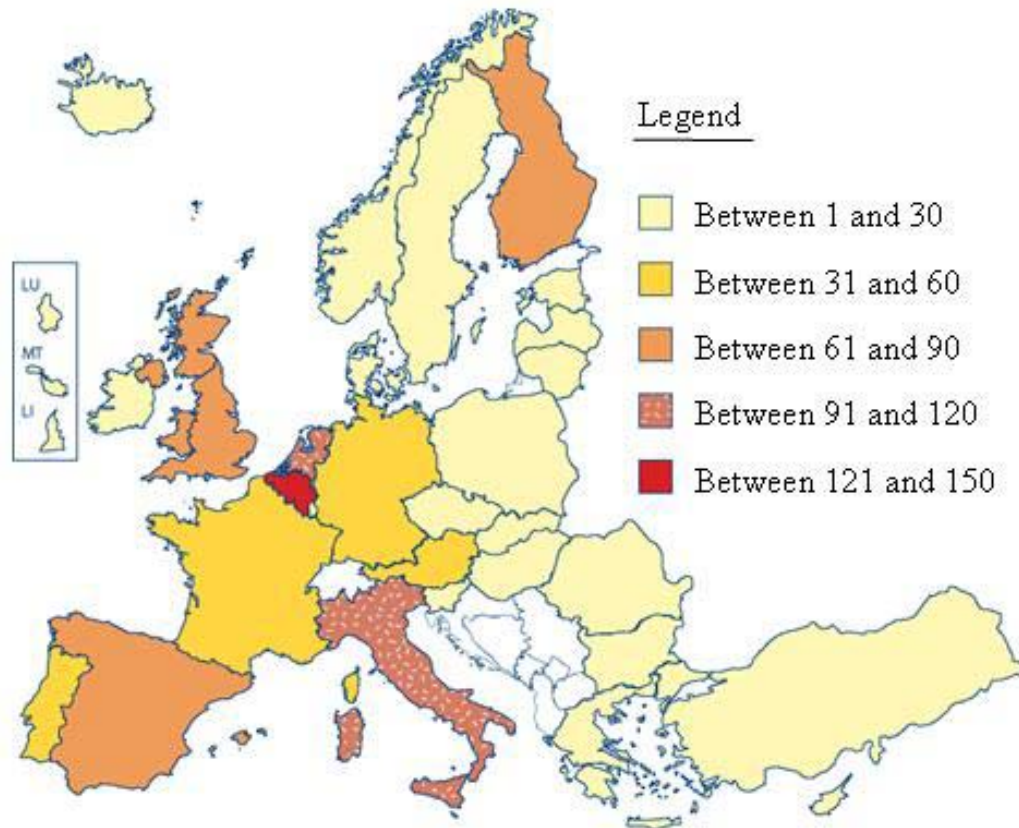
ERASMUS sub-actions 2007-2009 Success rate (%) by country



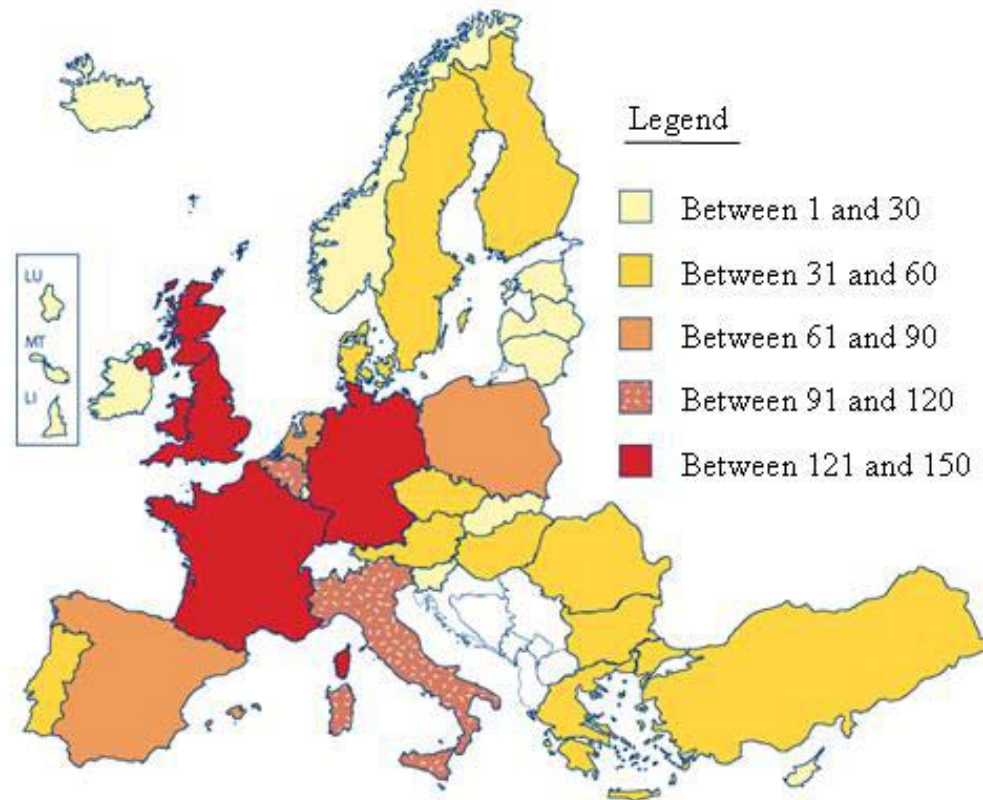

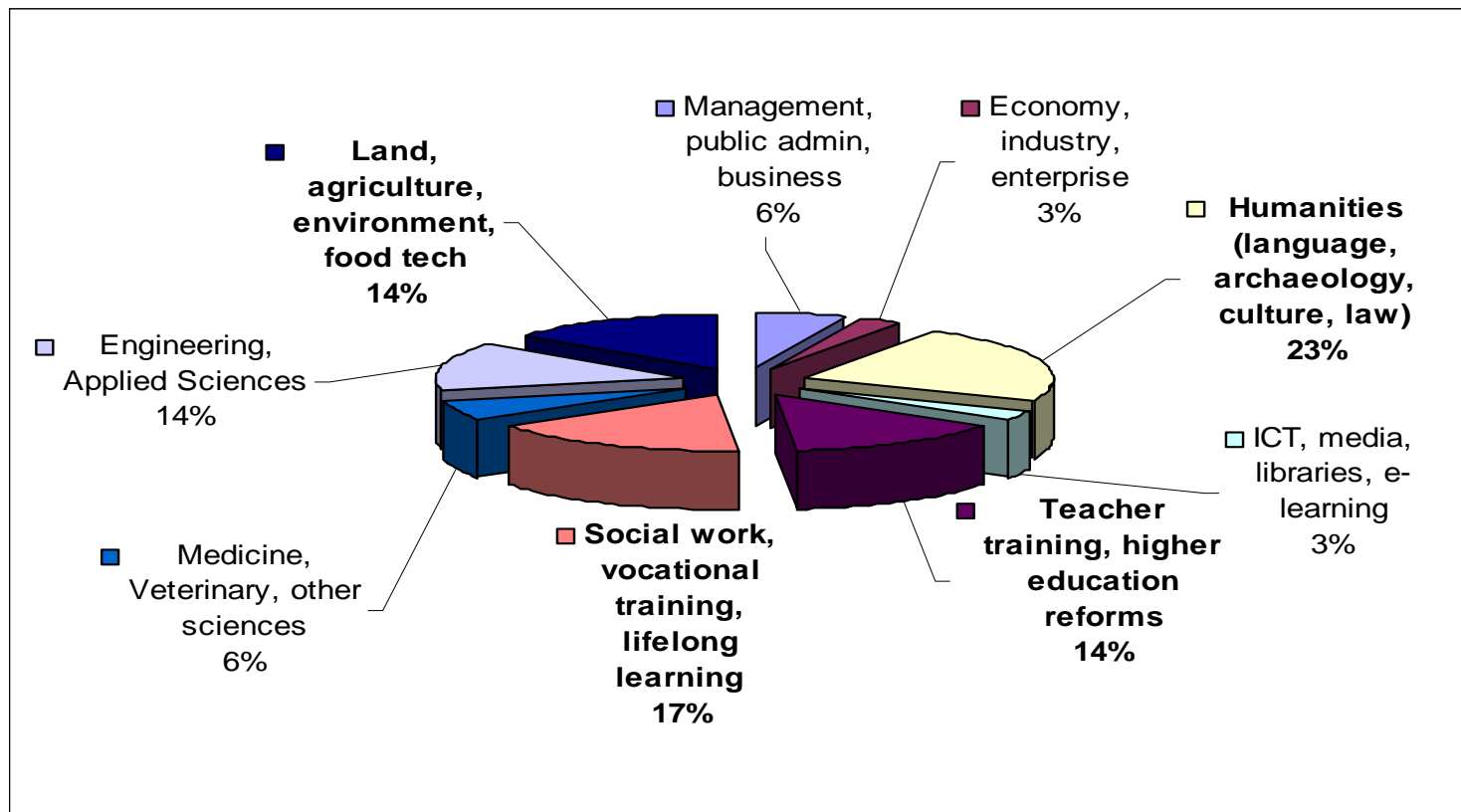
N° of Distinct Organisations participating as Coordinator/Beneficiary in Erasmus projects (2007 - 2009)



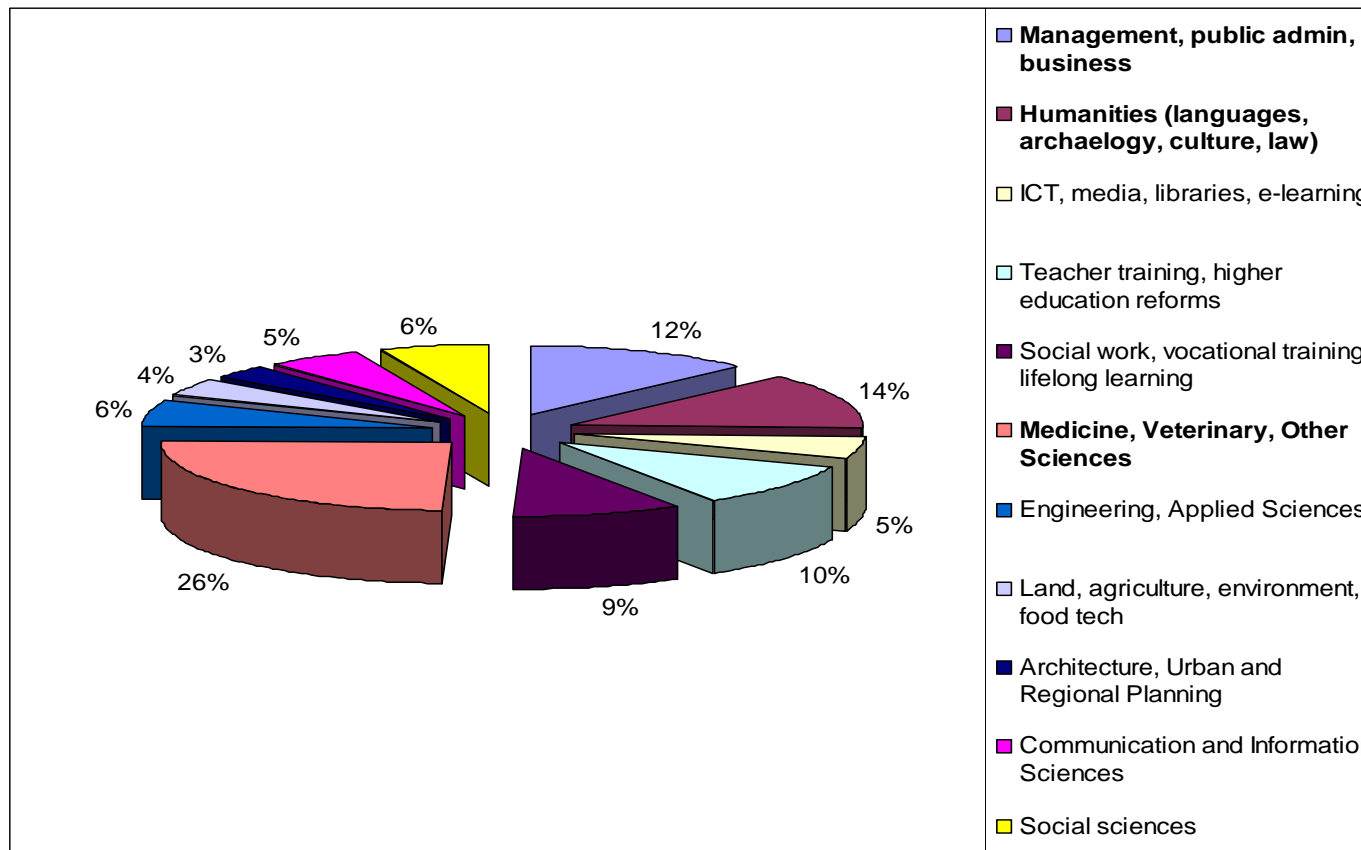
N° of Distinct Organisations participating as **Partners** in Erasmus projects (2007 - 2009)

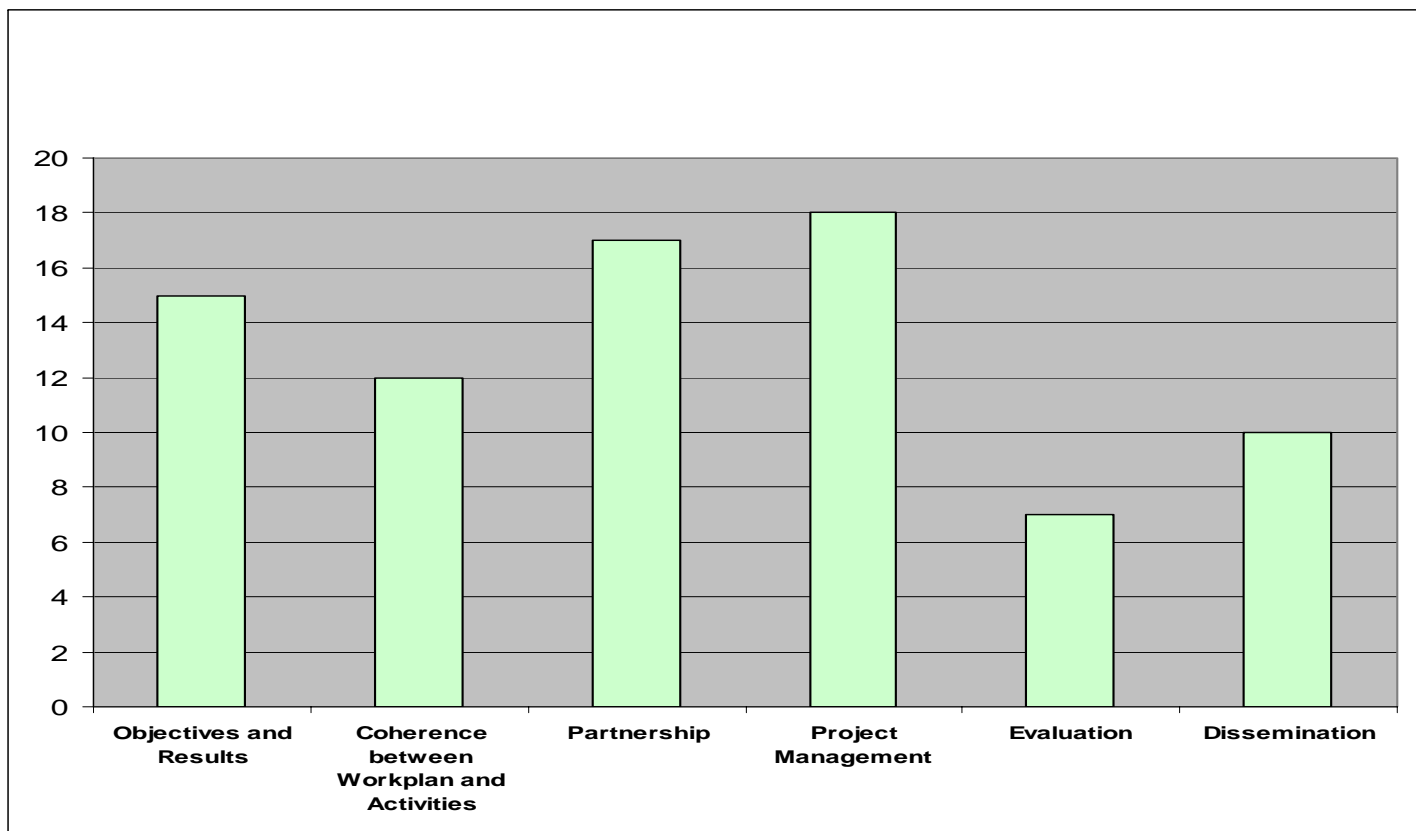
