13.7. Communication between the contracting authority and the experts:

All exchanges with experts, including the conclusion of contracts for their appointment and any amendments thereto, shall be carried out through the electronic exchange systems set up in accordance with Article 287(4) of Commission delegated Regulation (EU) No 1268/2012.

By submitting their application via the website mentioned in the call, experts agree to accept using the electronic exchange system for interactions with the Agency or the relevant funding body. All communications made through the electronic exchange system (including signature of contracts, amendments, notifications, requests for payments, etc.) are considered equivalent to communications made through paper documents, shall be admissible as evidence in legal proceedings, shall be deemed to be the originals of the documents and shall enjoy legal presumption of their authenticity and integrity provided that they do not contain any dynamic features capable of automatically changing them. The electronic signatures shall have the equivalent legal effect of handwritten signatures.
