Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degrees (EMJMD) & the Inter-University Exchange Project (IUEP)

...in brief:

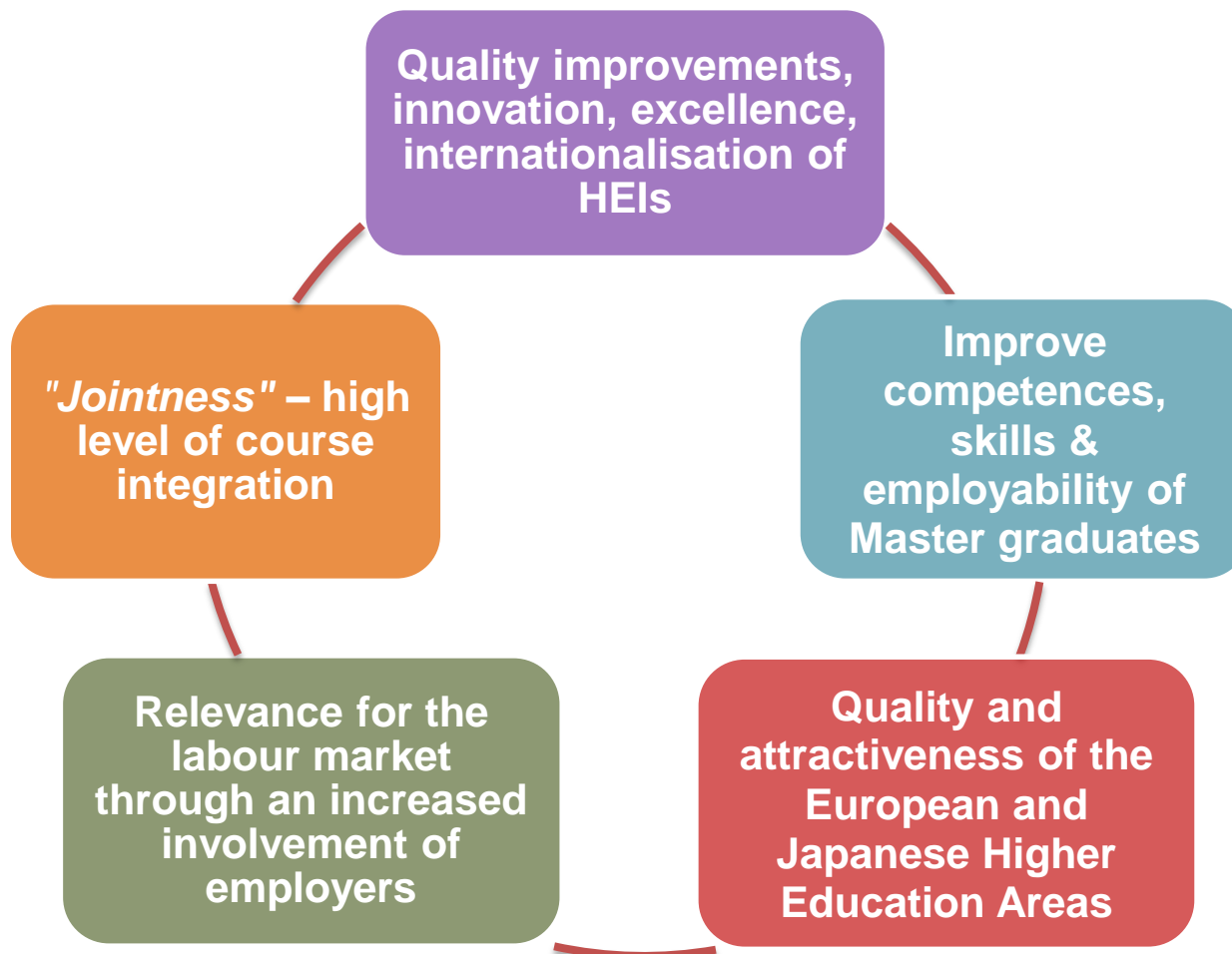
- ✓ Highly integrated Master study programmes delivered by international consortium of higher education institutions
- ✓ No restriction in disciplines
- ✓ Duration 12 – 18 – 24 months (60 – 90 – 120 ECTS credits)
- ✓ **Four (4)** consecutive student intakes & optional preparatory year
- ✓ Award of fully recognised and accredited joint / multiple(double) Master degrees
- ✓ High value scholarships for students & mandatory study periods
- ✓ Minimum required involvement of invited scholars/guest lecturers in each intake

Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degrees (EMJMD) & the Inter-University Exchange Project (IUEP)

...key features:

- ✓ Consortia consisting of:
 - at least 3 HEIs from Erasmus+ Programme Countries &
 - at least 1 HEI from Japan
- ✓ Japanese partner HEI designated coordinator for the JPN side
- ✓ max 32 scholarships funded by EU (+ 32 scholarships by MEXT)
- ✓ 2 student mobility periods: in a Japanese HEI and in a Programme Country HEI

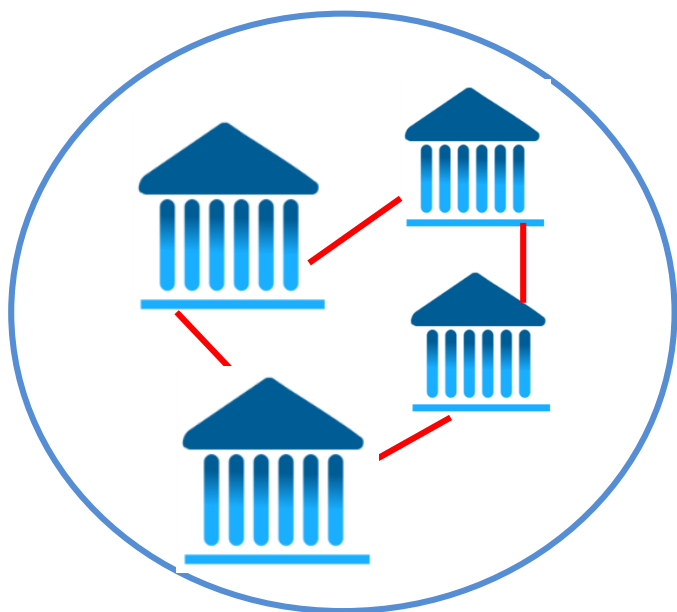

- ✓ must have a **first higher education degree** or equivalent
- ✓ must **not have received** an Erasmus Mundus scholarship/fellowship in the past
- ✓ can submit a scholarship **application to as many** EMJMD courses*
- ✓ must sign a **student agreement** with the EMJMD-IUEP consortium*

*applicable to the share of students managed by the programme country HEIs (EU scholarship and non-scholarship holders).

EMJMD-IUEP Award criteria

Relevance of the project (max 40 points)

Quality of the project design and implementation (max 20 points)

Quality of the project team & the cooperation arrangements (max 20 points)

Impact and dissemination (max 20 points)

- **Peer review** by independent external experts
- **One-step** evaluation procedure
- **2 thresholds:**
 - ✓ **75% (30 points)** of the maximum allocated points for **"Relevance"**
 - ✓ Proposals must score **at least 70 points** overall

EMJMD-IUEP EU funding rules

EU grant
~ 1.7 million €

HEIs



- 50.000 € per student intake (i.e. 20.000 € in total)
- 20.000 € for optional preparatory year
= 220.000 € max.

Students



- 49.000 € max. per scholarship
includes:
 - ✓ *participation costs*
 - ✓ *travel & installation costs*
 - ✓ *subsistence allowance*

EMJMD-IUEP EU-funded students

	Students from Partner Countries	Students from Programme Countries
Contribution to participation costs	up to 9.000 € per year	up to 4.500 € per year
Contribution to travel costs*	2.000 € per year if residence is less than 4.000 km from EMJMD coordinator 3.000 € per year if residence is 4.000 km or more from EMJMD coordinator	1.000 € per year
Contribution to installation costs*	1.000 €	-
Living allowance (max 24 months)	1.000 € per month (not when in country of residence)	1.000 € per month (not when in country of residence)



* Scholarship amounts for travel/installation depend on the place of residence at the time of scholarship application

Erasmus+ EMJMD-IUEP call for proposals 2019

EMJMD – Partnership with Japan

- ✓ Deadline: 1 April 2019 – 12:00 CET (Brussels time)
- ✓ Budget: ~3,4 M€ (per project), no scholarships for targeted regions
- ✓ N° of projects: ~3
- ✓ Grant Award Decision: by July 2019
