You can now validate and submit your application without the error.
- **PIC is not validated**: save and close your application. Next go to the [Participant Portal](#) and change the value from profit to non-profit **if relevant for the organisation**. Go to the application page (<https://eacea.ec.europa.eu/PPMT/>) and select "Revise list of participating organisations and update application for funding" (screenshot 3). You can now validate and submit your application without the error.
